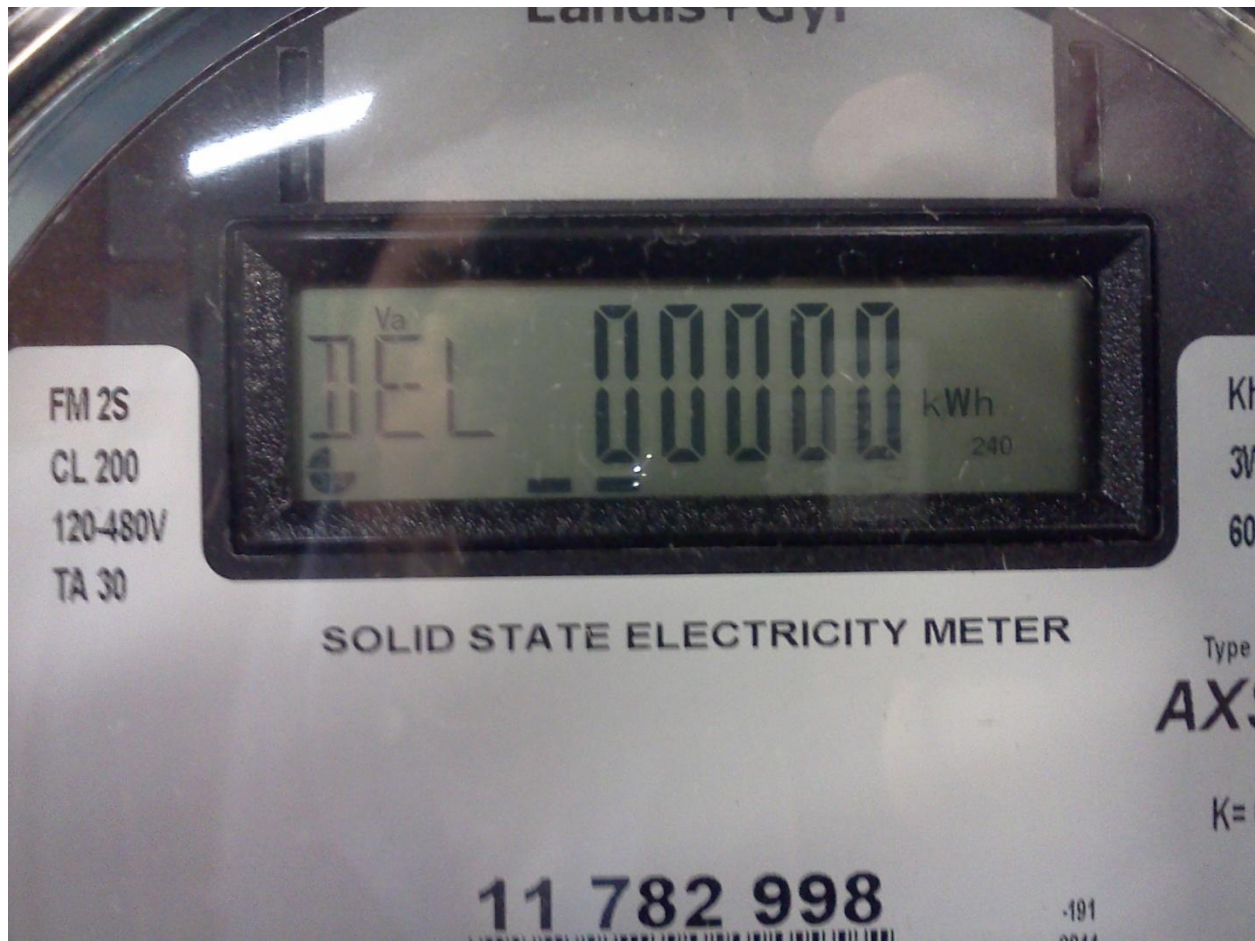


Net Metering Displays

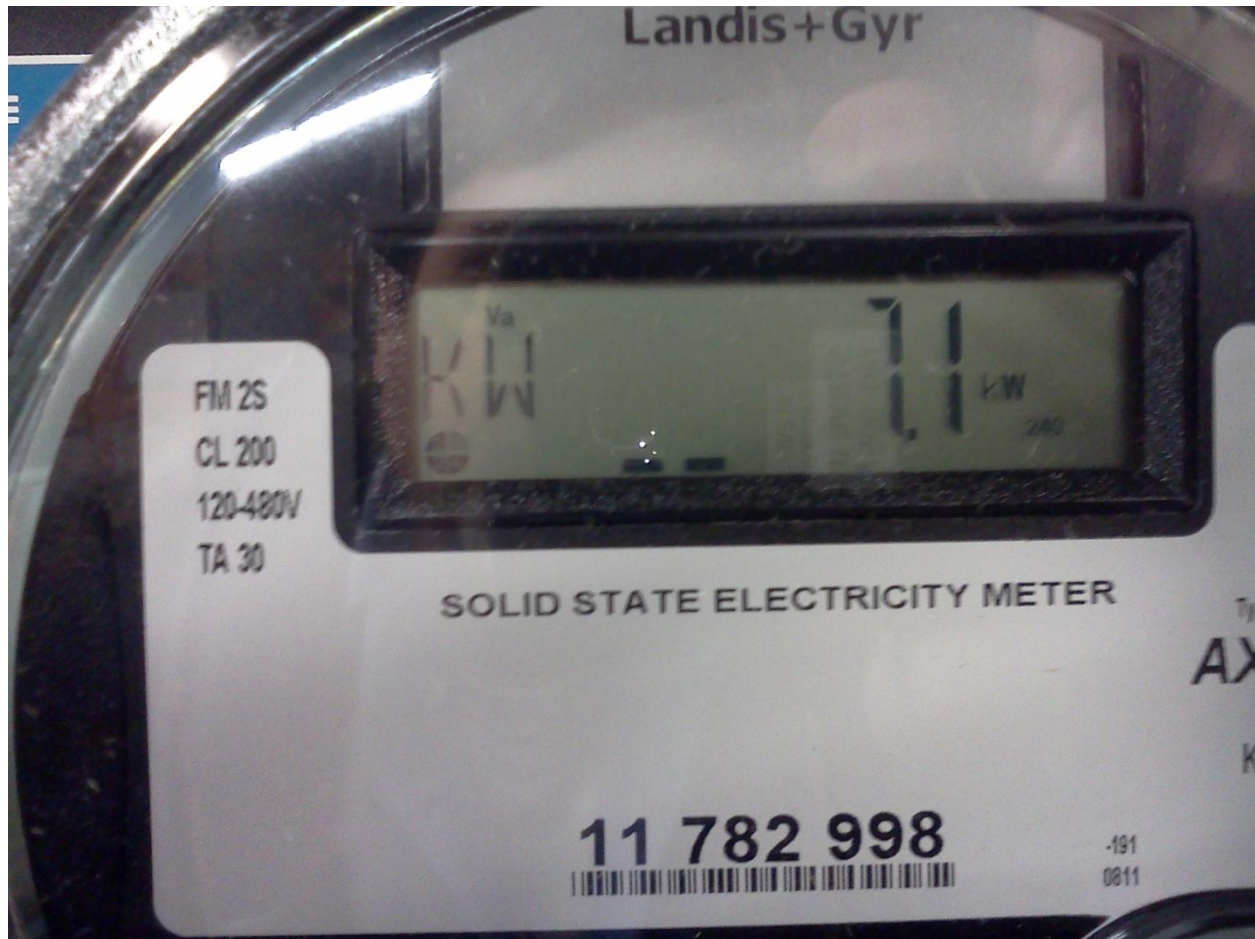
The meter will display “DEL” on the left hand side of the LCD display to indicate the cumulative amount of energy supplied to the customer by CPI. This can be thought of as the total amount of energy that has been supplied to the customer.



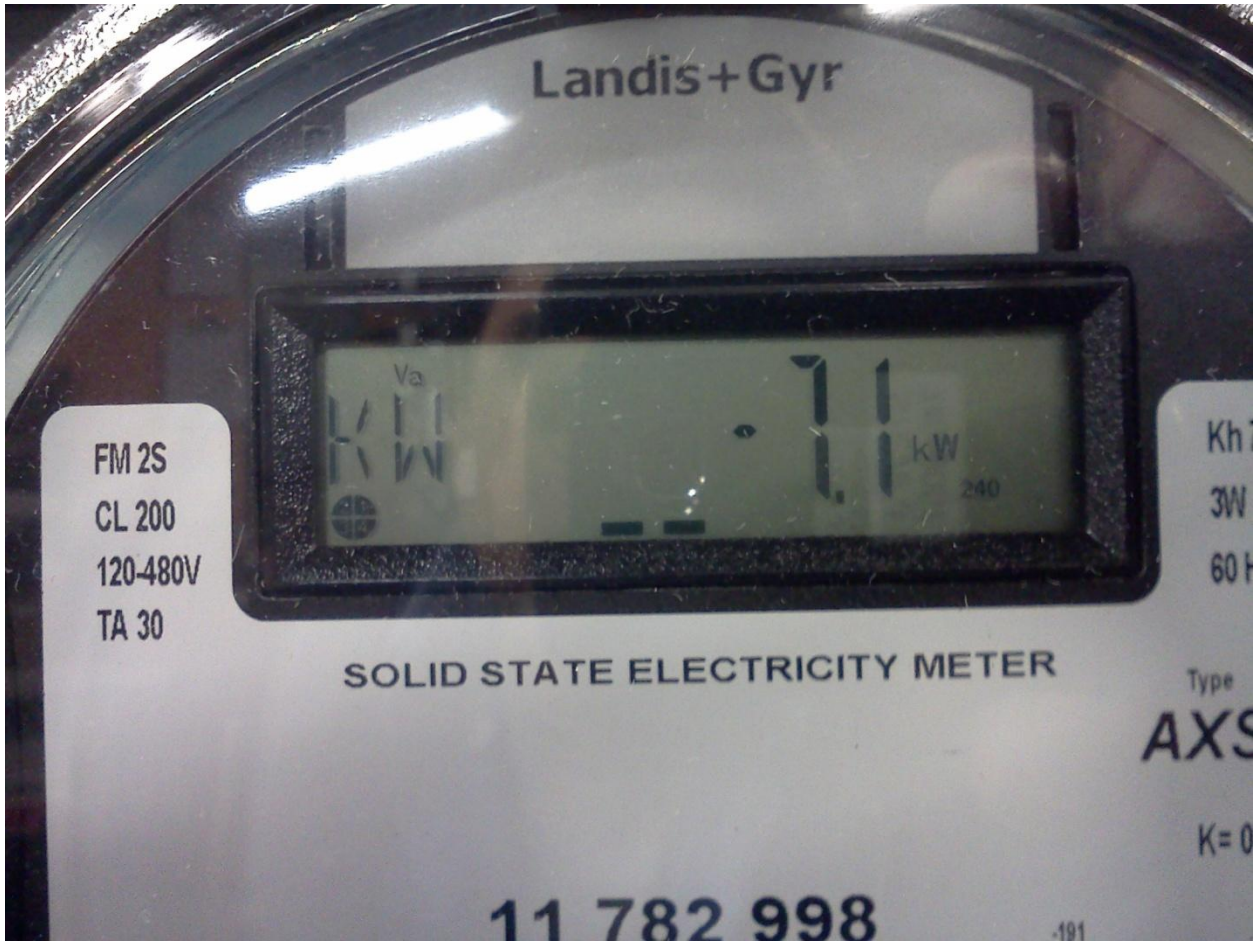
The meter will display "REC" on the left hand side of the LCD display to indicate the cumulative amount of excess energy that has been generated by the customer and returned to CPI's power system. This is not an indication of the total amount of energy generated by the customer but only the remainder of the generated power after the customer energy needs have been met.



The meter indicates “KW” on the left hand side of the LCD display to provide an immediate indication of how much power is being delivered to the customer or excess power being supplied by the customer to the power system. When energy is being provided to the customer from the power system the “KW” value will be positive. When energy is being returned to the power system from the customer the “KW” value will be negative.
